Meet Pili, a 9 year old boy who had never gone to school. He lost his father 5 years ago, and his Mom died last year, leaving 5 orphans. The aunt cannot care for Pili, so she came requesting help from Mercy and Caring Home. People come to the gate daily, where the words *mercy* and *caring* give them hope. Epong, the social worker is called, and he listens to their situations. Then he has to tell them "Poli" which means "Sorry". "We cannot help because we do not have enough funds."

Epong phoned last week. "Mama Nancy, when can we take in some more of the desperate cases we have on the waiting list? I am starting to dodge the guardians when I see them along my path. They keep asking when we can take the child." Mama Nancy replied,

"We cannot take in anymore new children until we get sponsors for the ones we have."

For every child to have two sponsors, we need 37 more.

"When did we see you hungry and feed you?" Jesus was asked as recorded in Matthew 25 "In as much as you did it to the least of these, you did it for me." Jesus replied.
